TOURNAMENT ENTRY FEE: \$25 for 1 event; \$30 for 2-3 events. Players are asked to bring cash or a cheque payable to "Badminton PEI".

ELIGIBILITY

The tournament is open to any player living in the Atlantic Region who is a member in good standing of his/her Provincial Association.

START TIME: Saturday – Registration at 9:00 a.m. At 9:30 a.m., play begins. Masters (35+) events begin at 10:30 a.m.

Sunday - Doors open at 9:00 a.m. At 9:30 am. Tournament play continues.

EVENTS:

Mens & Womens Singles, Doubles & Mixed Doubles

Masters Mens & Womens Singles, Doubles & Mixed Doubles

Minimum 4 players/teams for the event to be held.

FORMAT:

Main event and Masters -Single Elimination with Consolation –

Masters may play in the main round and masters round, but not in the same event.

Maximum of 3 events. Based on the number of entries , the Tournament Chair reserves the right to change the format or not run an event.

SHUTTLES:

All events are played with feather shuttles provided by participants.

The Masters events may play with plastic if all participants of a match agree.

Feather shuttles will be available to purchase.

Atlantic Championships – Six (6) shuttles will be provided for all finals.

TOURNAMENT DRAW:

The Atlantic Badminton Rankings published by NS will be used as a guide for the draw.

CODE OF CONDUCT:

The Atlantic Badminton Associations Code of Conduct will be in effect.

DRESS:

White or solid-colored top and shorts, and indoor sneakers are required. The use of goggles is recommended. **Junior players are to wear protective eyewear in accordance with their provincial association policy.**
