REGISTRATION:

- ◆ Deadline is April 12, 2014 Saturday at midnight.
- ◆ Registrations will only be accepted from Provincial Associations.
- ◆ Registrations will not be accepted from any individual, club or region.
- ◆ Associations shall rank their top 4 players/teams for each event in each category.
- ◆ Players may register and compete in an age category(s) above their current category; however they may only register for a maximum of three events.
- ◆ Players may only play singles in one age category, doubles in one age category and mixed doubles in one age category.
- ◆ The maximum number of boys or girls that a province can register is 16 per event per age category.
- ◆ The host province may invite the other provinces to register additional players if it cannot fill the draw(s).
- ◆ Each provincial association is asked to submit its entries in ranked order to the host province and must also send a copy at the same time to the other provinces. Each province has 48 hours from the registration deadline to protest rankings.

COACHES MEETING & DRAWS:

- ◆ The 2014 Championships will be single elimination play with a consolation round for all events. Draws will be made using the Atlantic Junior Championship approved draw formats, and will be reviewed by the Provincial Badminton Organizations prior to the competition to ensure all entries are accounted for and seeded players have been placed in the draws as required.
- ◆ **All questions regarding the draws should be addressed prior to April 25.** However, if minor changes need to be made, they can be brought to the meeting by one representative from each province.
- ◆ Coaches wanting their own copy of the draw prior to the tournament should contact their

respective Provincial Associations.

- ◆ **Protective Eye Wear:** Junior players are to wear protective eye wear in accordance with their own Provincial Association policy and insurance coverage.

CLOTHING:

- ◆ White or solid-colored top and shorts, and indoor footwear are required.
- ◆ While no caps are to be worn on the court, headbands and scarves are permitted.
- ◆ Track suits must be removed prior to the start of play.

BANQUET/SOCIAL:
